RE: Tumbler replacement

Here are some guidelines for replacing your tumblers.

1. Remove lock from rack frame and remove the mounting plate.
 2. Remove the two phillips screws from the back of the lock-these hold the electric solenoid in place.
 3. Carefully take out solenoid and the spring and pin.
 4. There is a threaded hole under the solenoid that has 1 or 2 set screws in it. Take the set screw out using a small allen wrench and check to see if there is a second set screw-if there is-remove it also.
- Note: If your tumbler is missing you should be able to see this set screw from the hole the tumbler usually mounts in.
5. Note carefully how the tumbler sits in the housing. From inside the lock push out the existing tumbler.
 6. Put the new tumbler in, with the flat side of the flange pointing up towards the set screw hole. Seat the tumbler in completely. A tap with a rubber mallet does the trick.
 7. Replace the set screw(s) and tighten-this is what keeps the tumbler from working loose and falling out.
 8. Replace the locking pin, spring and solenoid. Check to see that you can unlock the lock using the key.
 9. Remount the lock head on your rack.
